## ABOUT GRANT MALOY SMITH

Grant Maloy Smith is a Billboard Top 10 charting American Roots/Country artist. His album **DUST BOWL: AMERICAN STORIES**, spent 17 WEEKS on the charts, including 11 weeks in the top 10 of Billboard's Americana/Folk album sales chart.

His follow-up album **APPALACHIA: AMERICAN STORIES** received rave critical reviews, and the highly anticipated third album in the series, **MISSISSIPPI: AMERICAN STORIES**, is due in 2024.

## CONCERTS & APPEARANCES

Grant made his Carnegie Hall in 2018, and returned in April 2022, as well as Lincoln Center. He has performed all across the USA and in Europe in venues including **The Troubadour**, **The Bitter End**, The Fox Theater (Bakersfield), The House of Blues, The Factory at Franklin, The Station Inn (Nashville), The Allen Civic Auditorium (Texas), Feinstein's 54 Below (NYC), **The Bluebird Cafe** (Nashville), and hundreds more.

He has performed at music festivals like the Kicker Country Stampede in Manhattan, Kansas, The South Florida Folk Festival, The Connecticut Folk Festival, The Florida Winter Music Festival, and the Fringe Festival, and around the world in England, Scotland, Ireland, Italy, Slovenia, Germany, The Netherlands, and more.

He has performed on television at dozens of CBS, ABC, NBC and Fox affiliates across America, including syndicated shows like **SONG OF THE MOUNTAINS** (PBS), and **WOODSONGS OLD TIME RADIO HOUR** (PBS and Armed Services radio worldwide).

## AWARDS

He has won and been nominated in numerous music awards, including two Grammy® certificates, HMMA, HIMA, the NewSong Music Award, Akademia, The Indie Music Channel, and dozens more. In 2020 he was inducted into the Indie Music Hall of Fame at the **Grammy Museum** in Los Angeles.
